Rules from page one...

Constitution and By-Laws
Article IV
Section 4 paragraph

(c) Additional nominations may be made at the March meeting by any member in attendance provided that the person so nominated does not decline when his name is proposed, and provided further that if the proposed candidate is not in attendance at this meeting his proposer shall present to the secretary a written statement from the proposed candidate signifying his willingness to be a candidate. Except for the position of AKC Delegate, no person may be a candidate for more than one position, and the additional nominations which are provided for herein may be made from only among those members who have not accepted a nomination of the Nominating Committee.

(d) Nominations cannot be made at the annual meeting or in any matter other than as provided in this section.

NEWNAN KENNEL CLUB AKC OUTSTANDING SPORTSMANSHIP AWARD

1. Nominations may be made by any member of the Newnan Kennel Club.
2. Nominees must be a member of the Newnan Kennel Club and be in good standing with both the AKC and NKC.
3. The NKC president shall establish a Sportsmanship Committee each year, which will be made up of an odd number of people, containing a minimum of three people. At least one of the Sportsmanship Committee members must be a NKC officer or board member. The members of the Outstanding Sportsmanship Award Committee and their spouses will NOT be eligible for the award during the same time period that they sit on the committee.
4. There shall be no set criteria for the award. Nominations from the membership must be presented in writing, paper form or electronic mail, to the Outstanding Sportsmanship Award Committee and may be done at any point during the calendar year. The nomination need not be lengthy but should give sufficient reason why the nominated party should receive the award. It will be up to the committee to vote on all nominations presented to find the annual winner.
5. The winner will be announced at the Annual Awards dinner and the medallion will be presented at the same time. The award shall be a certificate framed and matted in an 8 ½ by 11-inch regular certificate frame.

NKC JUDGES REQUEST FORM

Voice your opinion of which judges you would like to have Judge at our shows and which judges you do NOT want. All request must be made in writing with a signature and phone number. Please be aware that judges are hired from 12 to 36 months in advance.

The purpose of this form is to communicate your desires. The Show Chairs shall hire the judging panels using these recommendations– so far as practical. However, the Show Chairs shall be obligated to contact the *Judge's Selection Chair* regarding a judge placed on the "No Hire" list before they attempt to hire that judge. The names of the judges selected by members shall be treated as confidential information between that member and the *Judge's Selection Chair*.

In selecting judges for our shows the chairs must take into consideration.....

- When a judge was last hired by our club
- Is the judge on the preference list OR the "NO" list
- Can the judge be shared with other club (reduces expenses)
- Has other club requested we share a judge that they have hired
- What breeds/classes the judge is qualified to judge
