REMINDER!!! OUTSTANDING SPORTSMANSHIP AWARD

1. Any member of the Newnan Kennel Club may submit nominations for the AKC Outstanding Sportsmanship Award.

2. Nominees must be a member of the Newnan Kennel Club and be in good standing with both the AKC and NKC.

3. The Sportsmanship Committee shall be comprised of the 3 most recent recipients of the Outstanding Sportsmanship award. Members of this committee and their spouses will not be eligible for the award during the same time period that they sit on the committee. The board shall appoint one of these members to chair the committee

4. There shall be no set criteria for the award. Nominations from the membership must be presented in writing, paper form or electronic mail, to the Outstanding Sportsmanship Award Committee and may be done at any point during the calendar year. The nomination need not be lengthy but should give sufficient reason why the nominated party should receive the award. It will be up to the committee to vote on all nominations presented to find the annual winner.

5. The winner will be announced at the Annual Awards dinner and the medallion will be presented at the same time. The award shall be a certificate framed and matted in an 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ by 11-inch regular certificate frame.

6. Following the Annual Meeting, the Chairman of the Sportsmanship Committee will inform AKC of the winner for publication on their website."

Minutes of the last Board Meeting (amend/approve): Ellen Connors made the motion, which was seconded by Melissa Harper to approve the minutes of the last Board Meeting as corrected. [Correction: Roll Call: (Quorum = a majority of the Board in attendance...]

Report of the President: No report.

<u>Report of the Secretary</u>: Carol Ann Beane reported that the club has received an email thank you note from Dixie Whitman thanking the club for inviting her to our January meeting. Email was received from AKC Agility Department announcing the launch of a new, beginning level agility program call ACT (Agility Course Test) which launches March 1, 2016.

Report of the Treasurer: Butch Jordan reported on the period ending 1/31/2016.

He also reported the following:

- Corporation Renewal Fees paid to the State of GA.; club insurance renewed for 2016 effective 2/15/2016; additional insured were added and we did not need to up the policy from one million to two million for Spring Show.
- Membership Report: we have 40 regular and 2 junior members.
- *Match and Fairgrounds*: checks for site fees and clean-up deposit have been mailed, along with a copy of club insurance to Coweta County Fairgrounds.
- *Fairgrounds*: Fees for the Coweta County Fairgrounds in 2016 have doubled over the 2015 fees unless reserved before 1/1/2016. Alternate sites were discussed. Various board members to follow-up. Further discussion re appeal to County Commissioners tabled until May.

Presented and circulated the 2015 financial report. Butch reported that our CPA has retired and all our records are now with a CPA in Fayetteville. The new firm will cost \$300 to file our taxes. Melissa Harper moved that we retain the new CPA firm to file our taxes for this year. Ellen Connors seconded. Motion carried.

AKC No report.

Committee Reports:

Agility: Ellen Connors reported that she sent in our application to AKC for 2017 without enclosing a check for fees with a letter stating that we will not have a trial in 2016. We will rebook in September.

Annual Awards: Lu Dunham reported that the 2016 Annual Awards Banquet will be held on Thursday, 5/5/2016 at the White Oak Golf Club. Wednesday date not available.

Breeder Referral: No report.

Equipment: Butch Jordan reported that renewals of our current storage facilities are due. Discussion followed. **Melissa** Harper moved that we move our Palmetto storage to the Newnan facility we already have and authorized Butch to rent a 10x10 unit or a 10x15 if the 10x10 is not available. Ellen Connors seconded. Motion carried.


